WHAT DOES THE BANCORP BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- account balances and payment history
- credit history and credit scores

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information, as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information, whether The Bancorp Bank shares your information, and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?

This privacy policy is provided by The Bancorp Bank and applies to the PayPal prepaid debit card and any related products and services.

What we do

How does The Bancorp Bank protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
We also limit access to information to those employees for whom access is necessary.

How does The Bancorp Bank collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- open an account or apply for a loan
- pay your bills or make a wire transfer
- provide account information

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?

Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *The Bancorp Bank has no affiliates with which it shares your personal information.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Nonaffiliates we share with can include online payment companies and prepaid card providers.*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *Our joint marketing partners may include online payment companies and prepaid card providers.*

Other important information

*California Residents -- In accordance with California law, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of The Bancorp Bank, unless the law allows. For example, we may share information with your consent, to service your accounts, or to provide rewards or benefits you are entitled to. We will not share information we collect about you with our joint marketing partners without your authorization. We will limit sharing around our companies to the extent required by California law.

*Vermont Residents --- In accordance with Vermont law, we will not share personal financial information about you, other than transaction experience information, with other Bancorp companies or affiliates, nor will we share any personal financial information about you with other Bancorp companies for marketing purposes.

* Nevada Residents -- We are providing you this notice pursuant to state law. You may be placed on our internal Do Not Call List by following the directions in the To limit direct marketing contact section.
